- Owners request: Neighbor's in Diamond Circle has requested that the curb at the end of their driveway be reduced in size. The Board agreed that they can research the problem; however, it could not be a patch cement job, and it cannot cause a drainage problem. They were given the HOA contractor's contact information. Who is following up on this?

Also there was a complaint regarding cars being parked on Diamond Circle. This will be addressed as a reminder in the next newsletter.

- Pond Report: BDR is a reliable and serious pond contractor. There is high confidence in their ability to do the job.
- Sun and Shade: A sprinkler valve called a Stop and Waste value, that is located near pond 2 is not currently leaking, however, it will need to be repaired off season in late fall or winter. The cost to repair is \$6,000.
- ARC: No new update
- Landscape: All Ash trees will be treated throughout the neighborhood.
- Welcome Committee: The revised and updated handbooks were to be mailed out the week of the HOA meeting.
- Bridge repair over pond 4 has been completed.
- Concrete: It was voted and agreed upon that due to our tight budget, there will not be concrete improvements made this year.
